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ow to	o understand the <i>context</i> of how and where the art is made:
1)	What is the subject of the art? (Is it a person, is it an event? etc.)
2)	What is the purpose of the art? (Is it to show emotion towards a certain subject, bring awareness, capture a scene? etc.)
3)	How do you connect what you see in the art with what you have learned about colour theory? (Think about how certain colours hold particular moods and emotions.)
4)	What kind of medium was used? How do you think this adds to the narrative, or perhaps take away from it?
